Regulation for the Reporting of Criteria Air Pollutants and Toxic Air Contaminants (CTR)

On November 19, 2020, California Air Resources Board (CARB) adopted amendments to the proposed Regulation for the Reporting of Criteria Air Pollutants and Toxic Air Contaminants (CTR). On October 28, 2021, the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) approved the amendments to CTR. **The amendments to CTR are effective January 1, 2022.**

The District enforces the state law requirements pursuant to District Rule 19.3 and as provided in the Regulation for the Reporting of Criteria Air Pollutants and Toxic Air Contaminants (Title 17, California Code of Regulations, Sections 93400 - 93410). CTR apply to all facilities that have been issued a Permit to Construct and/or Permit to Operate with the District except for those listed in Title 17 CCR 93401 (b).

CTR requires nearly all permitted facilities to meet specified reporting requirements for criteria pollutant and air toxics emissions on an annual basis by year 2028. The requirements are phased in for various facility types over several years. This is based on, industry sector, emissions source, and in some cases activity level.
