State Audit of APCD



- Ordered by Joint Legislative Audit Committee via a request in Aug. 2019 by then Assemblymember Gloria
- Audit Scope:
 - Financial Transparency
 - Cost Recovery
 - Public Outreach
- State Auditor's report issued in July 2020



APCD concurred with all recommendations



- Leverage State & Federal funding opportunities to reduce emissions from mobile sources
- Periodically notify Board of grants not pursued

Status of Implementation by APCD

- Applied for \$42 million in FY 20-21
 - \$22 million awarded to date



Presentation to the Board this year



- Establish methodology to calculate full cost of permitting program for stationary sources
- When economic conditions allow, propose annual fee increases by maximum allowable percentage until full cost recovery is achieved

- Cost Recovery Study has been completed
 - □ Findings & recommendations to be presented today



- Develop & implement a Public Participation Plan
 - Public outreach & engagement

- Awarded federal grant to support plan development
 - Open & public process completed this calendar year
 - Public Relations firm to help inform plan development
- Appointed a Community Outreach Coordinator

Status of Implementation by APCD

To be considered at a Board meeting this year



- Establish policies & procedures to validate information entered in APCD's database of air pollution complaints
- Periodically review accuracy & completeness of data

- Updated Policies & Procedures accordingly
- Enhanced systematic controls & reporting tools



- Complete an agreement with the County to continue receiving key administrative services
 - Information technology, legal counsel, contracting, human resources, fleet & facilities management

- Agreement approved on August 5, 2020
- Amendment approved on April 16, 2021
