**NOTICE OF INTENT  
TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR  
SAN DIEGO COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT RULE  
67.26 - COMMERCIAL CHARBROILING OPERATIONS BY THE SAN  
DIEGO AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT**

Notice, pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21092 and California Code of Regulations Title 14 Section 15072, is hereby given that the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (APCD) is proposing to adopt a Negative Declaration addressing San Diego County Air Pollution Control District Rule 67.26 - Commercial Charbroiling Operations, based on Initial Study findings prepared pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.

The APCD is proposing to adopt Rule 67.26 to address emissions from charbroiling operations. APCD, acting as lead agency, has completed an Initial Study for the proposed project. The Initial Study found no substantial evidence that the proposed project would have a significant adverse effect on the environment.

On the basis of these findings, a proposed Negative Declaration has been prepared. APCD is seeking comments on the proposed Negative Declaration. The 30-day review period commences on March 12, 2025 and ends on April 14, 2025. All comments must be submitted in writing or via e-mail and received at the APCD office by 5:00 p.m. on April 14, 2025.
