NAME:	AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT HEARING BOARD (APCD)
LEGAL AUTHORITY:	California Health & Safety Code Section 40800 et seq.; also 42350 et seq.
MEMBERS APPOINTED BY:	San Diego County Air Pollution Control District Governing Board
MEMBERSHIP COMPOSITION:	<p>One (1) Member admitted to practice law in this State</p> <p>One (1) Member who is a professional Engineer</p> <p>One (1) Member from the medical profession whose specialized skill, training or interests are in the field of environmental medicine, community medicine or occupational toxicologic medicine</p> <p>Two (2) Public Members</p> <p>The Governing Board may also appoint one alternate for each member. The alternate shall have the same qualifications as the member for whom such person is the alternate. The alternate may serve only in the absence of the member, and for the same term as the member. An alternate shall not hold any of the single member hearings.</p>
TERMS:	Three years
DUTIES:	Hear and decide appeals from permit denials, hear applications for Variances from Air Pollution Control District Rules and Regulations, and hear abatement order requests.
MEETING DATE AND LOCATION:	Second and Fourth Thursday, 9:00 a.m. 1600 Pacific Highway San Diego, CA 92101
COMPENSATION:	<p>Fifty Dollars (\$50) per day of service while sitting as a member of such Board in session; provided however, where such service of a Member during any day:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is performed partially in the morning and partially after 1:30 p.m. of such day, or... 2. Exceeds 4 hours, compensations shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100) for such day; and Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25) for hearing each request for Emergency Variance while not sitting as a member of such Board in session, not to exceed Seventy Dollars (\$70) per day. 3. Resolution 9/18/79 (112) and Section 490.17 of the County Administrative Code provides for mileage reimbursement.
