4527 San Diego County Air Pollution Control District, County of San Diego Abatement Order against Respondent NEW LEAF BIOFUEL.

Notice of time and place of hearing was given as required by law.

ACTION:

ON MOTION of Vice Chair Schlick, seconded by Chair Rodriguez, the Air Pollution Control District Hearing Board closed the hearing based on testimony provided and evidence submitted, the Board approved the attached Stipulated Abatement Order, as revised, between the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District, Petitioner, and New Leaf Biofuel, Respondent, based on the terms and conditions set forth in the Stipulated Abatement Order. This Abatement does not act as a Variance.

The Board has received evidence regarding the alleged odors from the plant's processing of used cooking oil and reviewed the amended Stipulated Abatement Order. The Board has found based on good cause and the need to implement control to eliminate the impact to the Residents of Barrio Logan from the biofuel process odors and has approved the amended Stipulated Order of Abatement, as presented and negotiated between the Air Pollution Control District and New Leaf Biofuels, as revised with the following provisions:

- 1) The District shall continue to refine the complaint inspections and provide the result to Respondent in a timely manner post inspection.
- 2) The Respondent is directed to complete a study of direct and indirect expenses related to coming into compliance. The report shall include:
 - a. Identification of agency and agency requirements
 - b. Execution of requirements
 - c. Operations maintenance

Petitioner and Respondent are to return to the Board with an update on the progress of the Abatement Order during a regularly scheduled meeting of the Air Pollution Control District Hearing Board on October 26, 2023.

The Board thereby granted the District's request for a Stipulated Abatement Order against Respondent, New Leaf Biofuel effective immediately.

ADDITIONAL ENFORCEMENT CONDITIONS

After a thorough investigation of all relevant facts, including public comments, it was determined that the schedule for compliance set forth in the Order is as expeditious as practicable, that the



terms of this Order comply with applicable sections of the State Health and Safety Code and that the following additional provisions shall apply:

- 1. If you believe that you cannot meet a condition in this Order or in any accompanying Schedule of Increments of Progress, you may petition the Hearing Board to modify this Order or Schedule of Increments of Progress pursuant to Health & Safety Code 40825, 40826, 42351.5, and 42356-42357. Modifying the Increments of Progress generally requires the same notice as a 90-day variance and extending the final compliance date requires the same notice as a regular variance; please consult the Hearing Board Calendar or Clerk for specific dates.
- 2. If you have any questions about how to comply with this Order, you may contact the District, attention Mary Mahoney, at (858) 248-5810. Unless otherwise stated, all submittals to the District pursuant to this Order shall be made to: San Diego Air Pollution Control District, Compliance Division, 10124 Old Grove Road, San Diego, CA 92131; or Email: mary.mahoney@sdapcd.org.
- 3. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) does not recognize variances granted under California state law. A Variance Order granted by this Board does not preclude either the EPA or citizens from seeking penalties for violations of federal law.
- 4. Failure to comply with any condition in this Order or in any accompanying Increments of Progress schedule may result in any of the following actions:
 - a. Enforcement pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 42400, 42401, 42402 or 42403, including possible judicial action for an injunction and/or civil penalties, and, in appropriate cases, criminal prosecution.
 - b. Revocation or modification of this Order under California Health and Safety Code Section 42356 or 42362, after notice and opportunity for a public hearing.

FAILURE TO COMPLY with any of the foregoing is a violation of this Order.

19	On October 27, 2022, the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (hereinafter, "District")						
20	Hearing Board issued a Stipulated Abatement Order (hereinafter "SAO") directed to Respondent, New						
21	Leaf Biofuel, LLC (hereinafter, "NLB"), and all employees thereof (hereinafter, "Respondents") related						
22	to NLB's operation of processing used cooking oil from local restaurants to produce biofuel at their						
23	facility located at 2285 Newton Avenue (hereinafter, "North Plant") and 2317 Newton Avenue						
24	(hereinafter, "South Plant") in San Diego, CA, 92113. The District alleged the SAO was required to						
25	address odors from NLB operations that resulted in violations of District Rule 51 "Nuisance" and						
26	California Health and Safety Code section 41700. Respondents have implemented the conditions in the						
27	SAO but odor complaints have been documented by the District and, as a result, another Notice of						
28	Violation was issued by the District to NLB on June 13, 2023. As a result, Respondents and the District						

1	propose to amend the SAO to include the following conditions, effective immediately upon adoption by					
2	the District Hearing Board:					
3	STIPULATED AMENDED CONDITIONS AND INCREMENTS OF PROGRESS:					
4	Both the District and Respondent reviewed and are in agreement with the following Conditions and					
5	Increments of Progress to supplement the SAO, and/or to memoralize actions already intended for					
6	implementation by Respondent.					
7	A. This amendment adds to the Conditions and Increments of Progress in the October 2	ent adds to the the Conditions and Increments of Progress in the October 27,				
8	2022 SAO and the additional conditions are to be implemented as specified at the North and					
9	South Plants.					
10	B. The portable carbon filter system ordered by NLB in April 2023 shall be used to capture an					
11	treat air produced or discharged from trucks loading, unloading, or during the transfer of					
12	potentially odorous material at the North and South Plants. This system shall be in operation					
13	by July 7, 2023.					
14	C. Used cooking oil collection containers returned to NLB for cleaning shall be stored in an					
15	enclosed manner at all times prior to collection by the cleaning contractor at the North and					
16	South Plants.					
17	D. Respondent shall investigate potential sources of odors at NLB and identify proposed					
18	measures to reduce those odors. The results of the investigation shall be reported to the					
19	District by, on or before June 30, 2023. The report should be emailed to

21	E. All other Terms and Conditions of the October 27, 2022 SAO remain in effect.
