**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION BY THE
SAN DIEGO COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT
TO ISSUE A FEDERAL TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT**

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with Regulation XIV - Title V Operating Permits of the San Diego Air Pollution Control District's Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a preliminary decision to approve application APCD2017-APP- 005413 for a renewal federal Title V Operating Permit APCD2009-TVP-974746 for Neo San Diego LLC, located at 5344 Convoy Street, San Diego, California 92111.

The District performed an evaluation of the air pollution impacts of this proposal. The equipment is expected to operate in compliance with all applicable District Rules and Regulations and all applicable federal requirements. The proposed Title V Operating Permit incorporates conditions necessary to ensure compliance with all federal and District requirements. The facility is currently operating in compliance with District requirements.

The District is seeking comments on the Title V Operating Permit for this facility. Written comments concerning the District's proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days commencing on September 20, 2018 and ending on October 20, 2018. Documents relating to the proposed action are available for public review at this address.
