NOTICE TO APCD PERMIT HOLDERS

Invoice for Annual Operating Fees

Due to the ongoing economic challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, on December 9, 2020, the San Diego County Air Pollution Control Board voted to extend the deferral for the payment of some APCD Annual Operating Fees. As a result, all Annual Operating Fees which would normally have been due between July 1, 2020 and March 31, 2021 are now due for payment by 5 PM on April 1, 2021. The enclosed invoice reflects this fee deferral for your permit(s).

PLEASE NOTE:

- <u>Permit expiration dates are also deferred, but ONLY for purposes of delayed fee</u> <u>payments.</u> Regardless of the expiration date on the permit itself, all permits associated with deferred Annual Operating Fees will instead expire on April 1, 2021, if the fees have not been paid. However, compliance will not be deferred for other requirements which are based on the expiration date shown on the permit, such as source testing or performance testing requirements.
- You may pay your fees at any time prior to 5 PM on April 1, 2021.
- <u>Late fees will accrue after April 1, 2021</u>. Payments made after 5 PM on April 1, 2021 will be subject to the late fee provisions of District Rule 40(g).
- <u>The payment process is the same</u>. There will be no changes to methods of payment. You may still pay by check or credit card.
- <u>This is a one-time deferral</u>. The fee deferral only applies to fees due between July 1, 2020, and March 31, 2021. The renewal month for your permit will not change.
