**NOTICE OF RULE ADOPTION
RULE 97 - EMERGENCY VARIANCE
RULE 98 - BREAKDOWN CONDITIONS: EMERGENCY VARIANCE
(Amendment)**

The Air Pollution Control Board adopted amendments to Rules 97 and 98 which became effective May 28, 1991. Rules 97 and 98 are existing rules which define the procedures to be followed when filing for an emergency variance and define equipment breakdown conditions. The rules also outline the findings that must be met as well as the procedures to be followed by the Clerk of the Hearing Board and the Hearing Board member(s) in dealing with emergency variances. The amendments to Rule 97 delete reference to rules no longer in effect. Rule 98 has been amended to reflect current procedures in handling requests for emergency variances during equipment breakdown conditions.
