COMPLIANCE ADVISORY

Notice of Changes to Tables I, II, III of Rule 1200 and Rule 1210

The Air Pollution Control District has revised Tables I, II and III of Rule 1200 and Rule 1210. These tables list Toxic Air Contaminants with potential carcinogenic, chronic non-cancer and acute non-cancer impacts that must be evaluated under these rules.

Applicability

Rule 1200 applies to new, relocated, or modified emission units which may increase emissions of one or more toxic air contaminant(s) and for which an Authority to Construct or Permit to Operate is required, or for which a Notice of Intention or Application for Certification has been accepted by the California Energy Commission.

Rule 1210 applies to each stationary source required to prepare a public health risk assessment pursuant to Section 44360 of the Health and Safety Code.

What has changed?

104 new compounds have been added and health values for some previously adopted compounds have been revised.

What do these changes mean?

The acute and chronic non-cancer and the carcinogenic health effects of these compounds will be considered in reviews of new, relocated, or modified sources emitting toxic air contaminants per Rule 1200. In addition, these compounds will also be evaluated when determining public notification and risk reduction requirements pursuant to Rule 1210.

Why are these changes necessary?

Rules 1200 and 1210 require calculation of health effects to be based on health values recommended by the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA). OEHHA periodically adopts new health values or revises health values based on new health effects information. This change incorporates new or revised values adopted by OEHHA as of January 22, 2001.
