HALOGENATED SOLVENT CLEANING**

WORKSHOP REPORT

A workshop notice concerning implementation of amendments to Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 63, Subpart T—National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) for Halogenated Solvent Cleaning was mailed to all owners or operators who use halogenated solvents in cleaning operations and all other facilities with vapor degreasing operations. Notices were also mailed to all Economic Development Corporations and Chambers of Commerce in San Diego County, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the California Air Resources Board (ARB), and other interested parties.

The workshop was held on April 23, 2008. One person attended the workshop and provided oral comments.

The workshop comments and Air Pollution Control District responses are as follows:

1. WORKSHOP COMMENT

Does this regulation apply to vapor degreasers?

DISTRICT RESPONSE

This regulation applies to vapor degreasers that use any solvent containing methylene chloride, perchloroethylene, trichloroethylene, 1,1,1-trichloroethane, carbon tetrachloride, or chloroform in a total concentration greater than 5 percent by weight as a cleaning or drying agent. Vapor degreasers that do not use cleaning solvent containing any of the above-mentioned halogenated solvents are not subject to this NESHAP.
