NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION TO REVISE REGULATION X – STANDARDS OF PERFORMANCE FOR NEW STATIONARY SOURCES BY THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (District) hereby gives notice that the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a preliminary decision to update Regulation X – Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources.

On January 29, 2020, the Air Pollution Control Board (Board) adopted a procedure for locally adopting any federal amendments to the provisions of Part 60, Chapter I, Title 40, of the Code of Federal Regulations, (40 CFR 60), applicable to the Subparts listed in Regulation X which were previously adopted by the Board. Any subsequent federal amendments to a previously locally adopted Subpart will be automatically incorporated by reference into Regulation X after the District conducts outreach to affected sources and the Board and completes a public notice process.

The proposed amended Regulation X will adopt by reference the current federal versions of the following 9 Subparts of Title 40, Chapter 1, Part 60, of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR Part 60): A (General Provisions), Kb (Volatile Organic Liquid Storage Vessels), AAA (New Residential Wood Heaters), WWW (Municipal Solid Waste Landfills), CCCC (Commercial and Industrial Solid Waste Incineration Units), IIII (Stationary Compression Ignition Internal Combustion Engines), JJJJ (Stationary Spark Ignition Internal Combustion Engines), KKKK (Stationary Combustion Turbines), and QQQQ (New Residential Hydronic Heaters and Forced-Air Furnaces). The amendments to these 9 Subparts include clarifications and corrections. The amendments are not anticipated to impact any existing permit holders.

The proposal is available for public review at the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District, 10124 Old Grove Road, San Diego, CA 92131.
